

## APPLICATION TO SERVE ON THE NEHALEM CITY COUNCIL

All applicants for City Council must have resided in the Nehalem City Limits for a period of not less than twelve (12) months prior to their appointment. All applicants must be a registered voter to be considered for appointment. Vacant elective offices in the City shall be filled by appointment by the mayor and approved by a majority of the incumbent council members. Vacancies shall be filled after 30 days public notice. The appointee's term shall begin immediately upon his/her appointment and shall continue until the beginning of the year following the next general biennial election and until his/her successor is qualified.
